# ICTWays Workshops

Since the ICTWays Network creation, the partners have done some workshops for teachers, to help them use ICT in the classroom.

The Ataköy Cumhuriyet Anadolu Lisesi, from Turkey, organized three workshops:

1. Basic ICT Skills, 12th to 19th March;
2. Basic Usage of Smartboards and its software Starboard, 25th March to 1st April;
3. Basic Usage of Smartboards and its software Starboard, 15th to 22 April.

The first workshop on basic usage of smart boards and its software named Starboard. The workshop was at the basic level. Word, excel, powerpoint etc. applications, simulations, starboard software and other basic level trainings were given. The workshop composed of 30 hours and 20 teachers from İstanbul Ataköy High School attended it.





The second workshop was mainly about the usage of StarBoard software in order to make teachers use smart boards effectively. 12 teachers from Ataköy High School attended it and it took 30 hours.
